## Frantoio Olive Tree

---

Tree or lollipop option.

Grows well in milder climates. This olive tree grows with moderate speed and has an airy, even wispy, canopy.





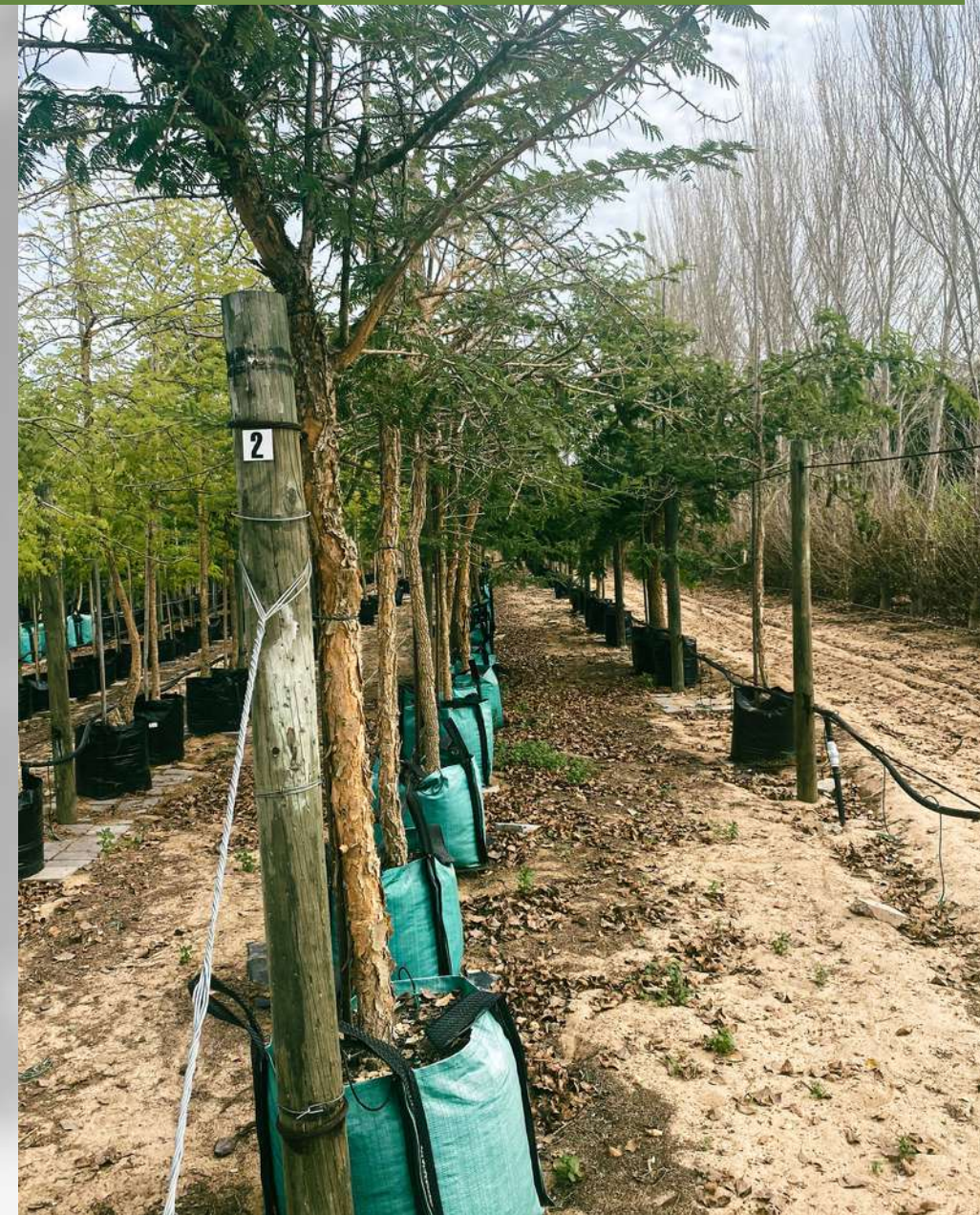
## Syzygium Guineense

---

Also known as Water Pear.

This is a lovely medium-sized to large evergreen tree with a smooth greyish-white single stem on young trees and beautiful purplish-red young leaves. This tree is grown in gardens for its deep shade.



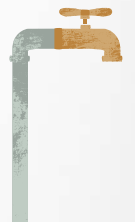


## Acacia Sieberiana Wood

---

Also known as Paperbark Tree.

A magnificent, widely spreading, flat crown (12 m high, 16 m wide) of deep green, feathery foliage (deciduous) and attractive creamy-tan to yellow-brown corky bark.





## Aloe Bainesii

---

Also known as Tree Aleo.

It forms an excellent focal point in the garden. It is easily distinguished by its grey, smooth bark, green recurved leaves and salmon pink flowers in winter. It thrives in cultivation and is easily propagated.





## Citrus Eureka Lemon

---

These lemon trees grow well in large pots and are suitable for containers around the home and garden brightening up even small gardens and home spaces.

They will bear fruit for home use all year round, especially when grown in warm climates. Eureka Lemon bears abundant yellow-gold, oblong fruit, mostly in the spring and summer months.





## Citrus Lime Tahiti

---

It is a small tree with short spiny branches and light-green ovate leaves. Clusters of white flowers appear in spring and summer, followed by oval green seedless fruit of excellent flavor.

Lime needs well-drained neutral to slightly acid soil in sun, with ample moisture during the growing season.





## Citrus Naartjie Clementine

---

Clementines fruit is easy to peel, virtually seedless, juicy, and much less acidic than traditional oranges.

You can plant them outdoors or in a container if you live in a cooler climate; they make compact, vibrant house plants as well as ornamental statements in a yard. Clementine trees are some of the cold-hardest citrus, meaning you reap all of the rewards with very little hassle.

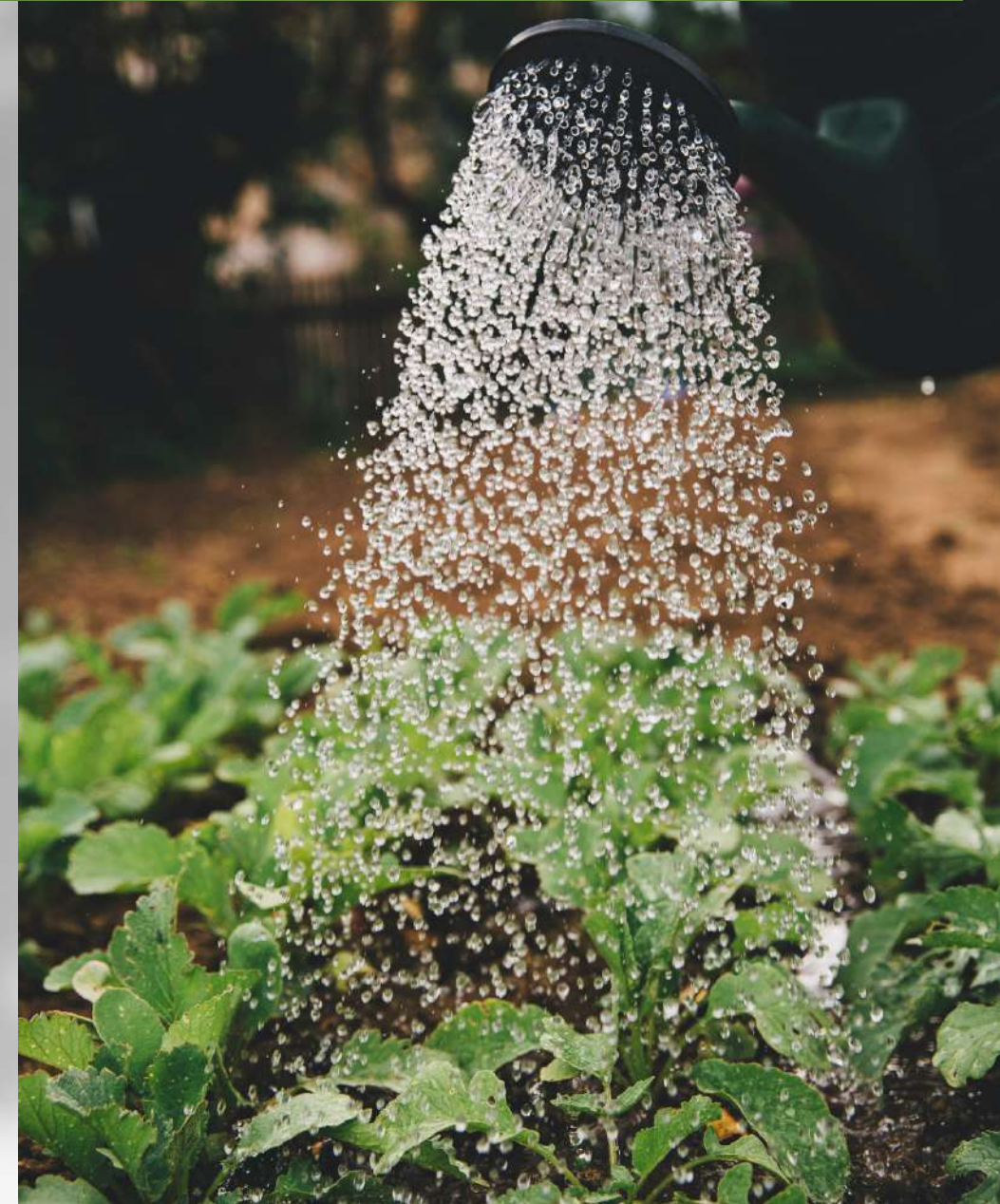

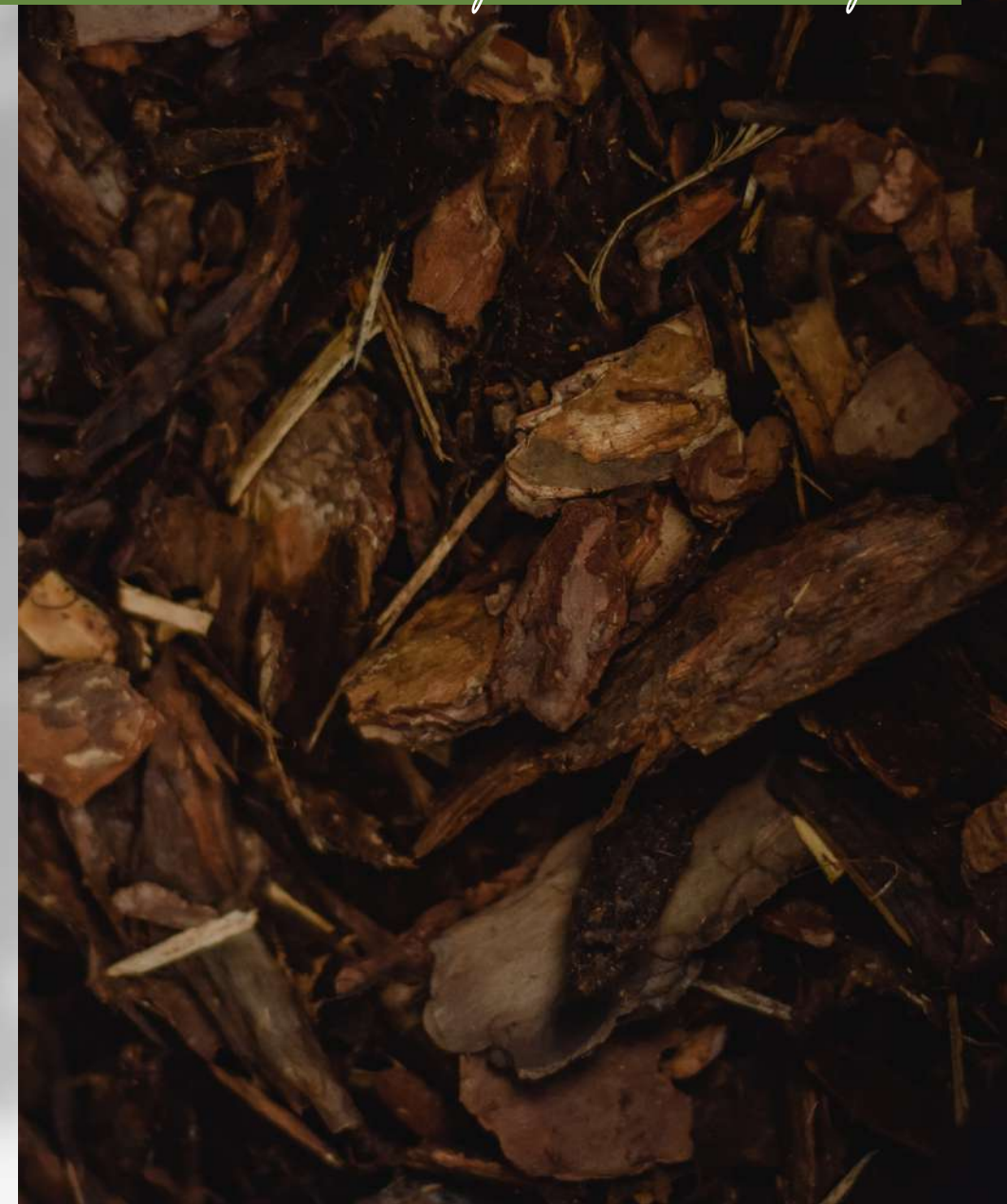

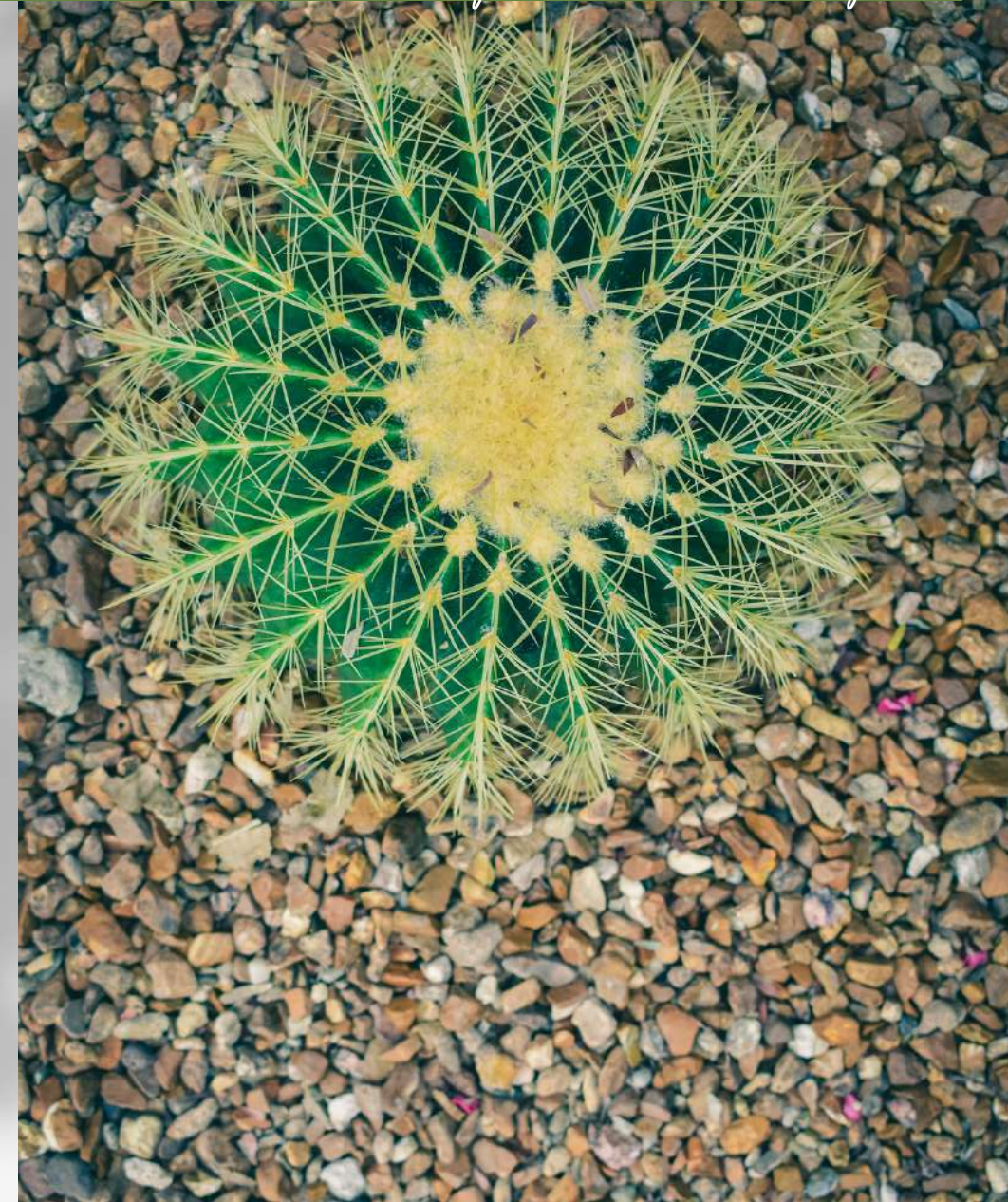
